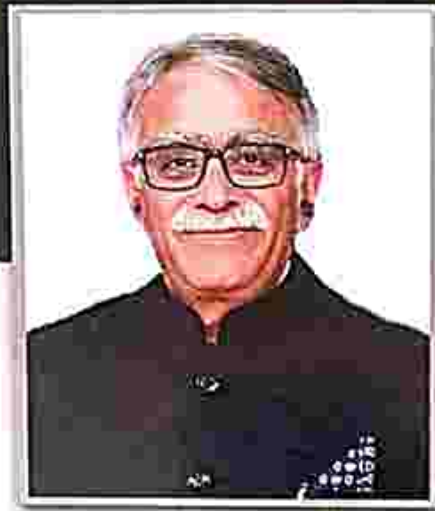

APRIL - 2018

NATIONAL LOK ADALAT :

On 22.04.2018, Monthly National Lok Adalat was conducted as per guidelines of NALSA wherein 4130 numbers of cases were taken up for disposal in total 46 Nos. of Courts and out of that 701 nos. of cases were disposed of on settlement and a sum of Rs. 1,41,48,389.50/- was realized as settlement amount.

SPECIAL LOK ADALAT :

- i. On 08.04.2018, under DLSA, West, a Special Lok Adalat was conducted where, 9000 numbers of M.V Act Cases & T.P Act cases were taken up for disposal, among them 4110 numbers of cases were disposed of and the total settlement amount was Rs. 2,88,400 /-.
- ii. On 22.04.2018, under DLSA, Gomati, another Special Lok Adalat was conducted where, 403 numbers of M.V Act Cases & T.P Act cases were taken up for disposal, among them 156 numbers of cases were disposed of and the total settlement amount was Rs. 35,500 /-.

TRADITIONAL LOK ADALAT :

- i. On 28.04.2018, under SDLSC, Bishalgarh, a Traditional Lok Adalat was conducted where, 3600 numbers of M.V Act Cases, TE Act, TG Act & T.P Act cases were taken up for disposal, among them 1886 numbers of cases were disposed of and the total settlement amount was Rs. 1,96,940 /-. Member Secretary, TSLSA also attend the said Lok Adalat.

On 30.04.2018, under SDLSC, Longtharaivalley, a Traditional Lok Adalat was conducted where, 1500 numbers of M.V Act Cases were taken up for disposal, among them 1320 numbers of cases were disposed of and the total settlement amount was Rs. 89,520/-.

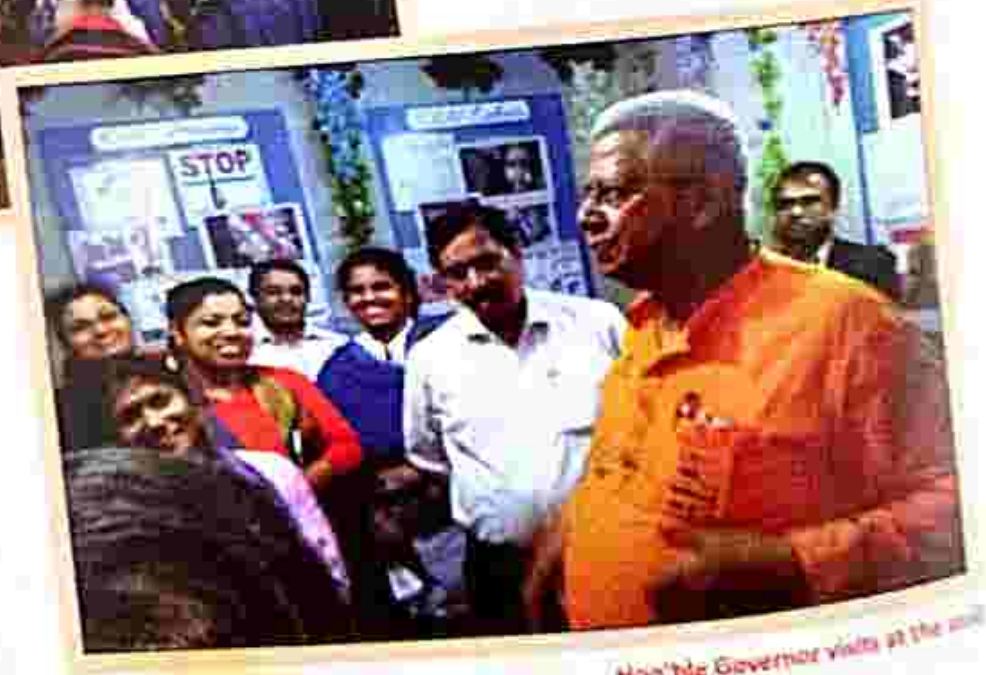

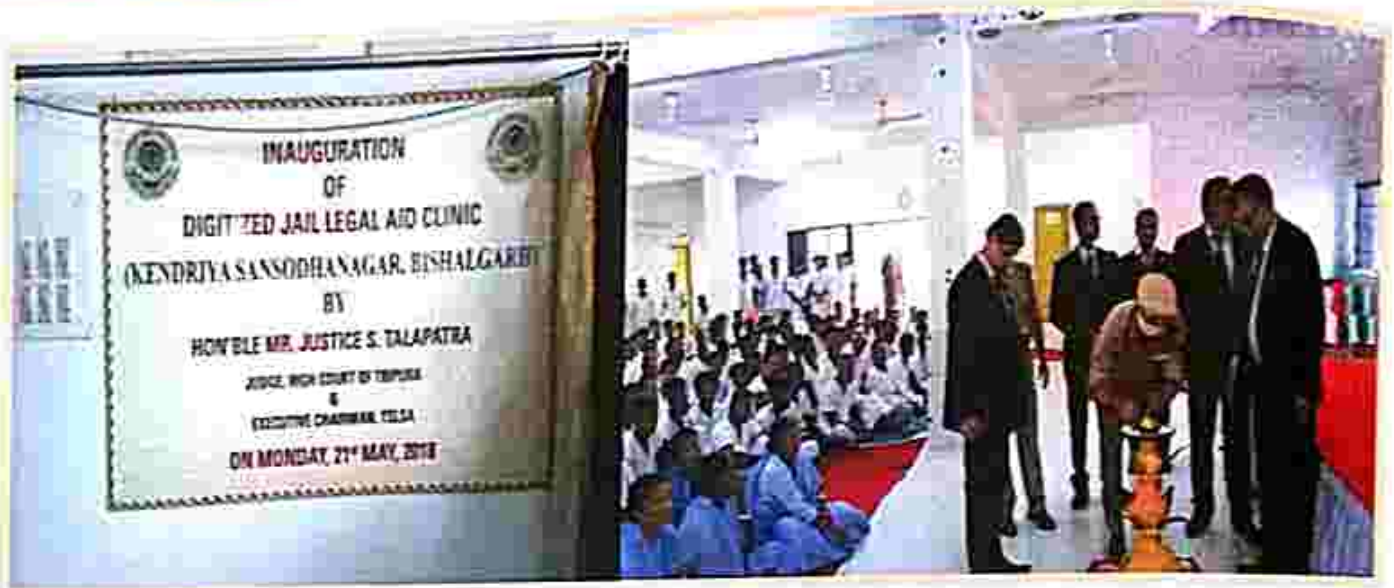

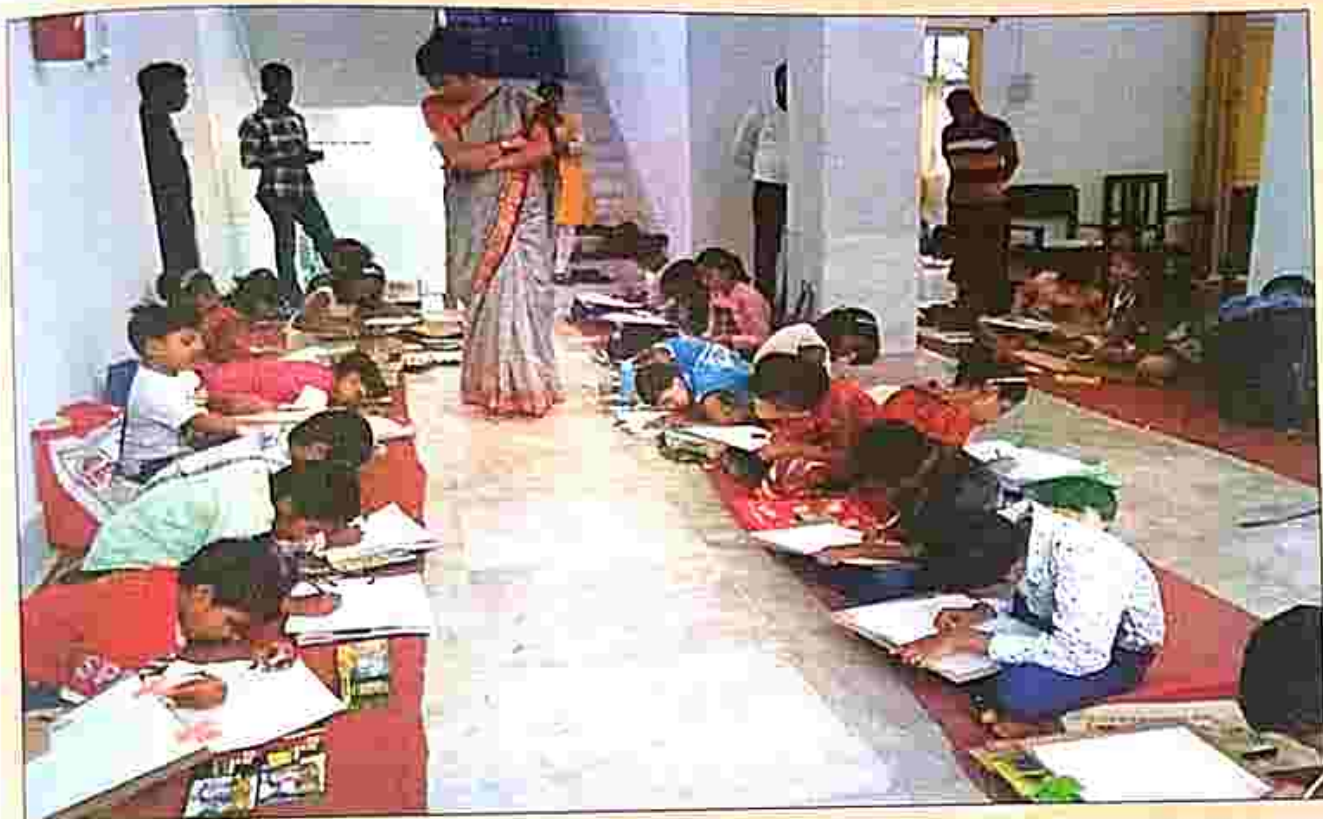

Agartala, April 22: Along with other parts of the country, Tripura State Legal Service Authority (TSLSA) conducted National Lok Adalat today at 46 locations of the state to resolve different type of cases.

Tripura State Legal Service Authority (TSLSA) through a press communiqué said that based on the directives of National Legal Service Authority, a total of 46 courts of Tripura including High Court has resolved the pending cases of motor vehicle act, NI act, matrimonial cases, BSNI, bill recovery cases, civil and criminal compoundable cases, family disputes, bank's non-performing asset case, disposal of Traffic Chillian cases etc.

TSLSA added that altogether 4,130 pending cases were taken up in courts for disposal, but only 701 cases were resolved on today and a total of Rs.1. 41, 48,389 awarded money was also collected during disposal of cases.

Earlier, the summons to all the parties of these cases were issued by the respective courts and TSLSA has requested all concerned persons to remain present on the scheduled date in their respective courts for disposal of pending cases. TSLSA added that, maximum cases were not disposed in absence of parties related to the cases. Despite poor presence of prosecution and defence parties, it is encouraging that the people are taking interest and more and more cases are being resolved day by day, said an official of TSLSA.
