ACCESS TO JUSTICE FOR ALL



*T*raditional Lok Adalat :

- i. On 09.06.2019, under SDLSC, Sonamura, a Traditional Lok Adalat was conducted where, 817 numbers of cases under M.V Act , Tripura Excise Act, Tripura Grambling Act & Tripura Police Act were **taken up** for disposal, among those 704 numbers of cases were **disposed of** and the total **settlement** amount of **Rs. 42,050 /-** was realised as settlement.
- ii. On 23.06.2019, under SDLSC, Bisalgarh, a Traditional Lok Adalat was conducted where, 410 numbers of cases under M.V Act , Tripura Excise Act, Tripura Grambling Act & Tripura Police Act were **taken up** for disposal, among those 238 numbers of cases were **disposed of** and the total **settlement** amount was **Rs. 9,810 /-**.
- iii. On 30.06.2019, under SDLSC, Belonia, a Traditional Lok Adalat was conducted where, 1110 numbers of cases under M.V Act , Tripura Excise Act, Tripura Grambling Act & Tripura Police Act were **taken up** for disposal, among them 1030 numbers of cases were **disposed of** and the total **settlement** amount was **Rs. 1,19,350 /-**.

*S*pecial Lok Adalat :

- i. On 09.06.2019, under SDLSC, Longtorai velley, a Special Lok Adalat was conducted where, 1500 number of cases under M.V Act & Tripura Police Act were **taken up** for disposal, among these 969 numbers of cases were **disposed of** and the total **settlement** amount was **Rs. 87,740 /-**.
- ii. On 16.06.2019, under DLSA, West Tripura, another Special Lok Adalat was conducted where, 57 numbers of claim cases under M.V Act were **taken up** for disposal, among these 03 number of cases were **disposed of** and the total **settlement** amount was **Rs. 1,96,000 /-**.
- iii. On 22.06.2019, under DLSA, South Tripura, Gomati and SDLSC Amarapur another Special Lok Adalat was conducted where, 121 number of cases MV Act, were **taken up** for disposal, among these 24 number of cases were **disposed of** and the total **settlement** amount was **Rs. 7,40,600 /-**.



iv. On 13.07.2019, National Lok Adalat was conducted as per guidelines of NALSA wherein 6018 number of cases were taken up for disposal in total 48 Nos. of Courts and out of these 795 nos. of cases were disposed of on settlement and a sum of Rs. 1,52,75,409/- was realized as settlement amount.

On 14.09.2019, National Lok Adalat was conducted as per guidelines of NALSA wherein 2324 number of cases were taken up for disposal in total 44 Nos. of Courts and out of these 378 nos. of cases were disposed of on settlement and a sum of Rs. 2,20,18,792/- was realized as settlement amount.

Mobile Lok Adalat :

On 22.06.2019, under SDLSC, Amarpur and SDLSC, Khowai Mobile Lok Adalats were conducted where 60 numbers of Bank loan recovery cases were taken up for disposal, among these 13 numbers of cases were disposed of and the total settlement amount was Rs. 26,27,395 /-.

Traditional Lok Adalat :

- i. On 21.07.2019, under DLSA, West Tripura, a Traditional Lok Adalat was conducted where, 665 numbers of cases under M.V Act , Tripura Excise Act, Tripura Gambling Act & Tripura Police Act cases were taken up for disposal, among these 372 number of cases were disposed of and the total settlement Rs. 14,800 /- was realised as settlement amount.
- ii. On 08.09.2019, under DLSA, West Tripura, a Traditional Lok Adalat was conducted where, 779 number of M.V Act Cases, Tripura Excise Act, Tripura Gambling Act & Tripura Police Act cases were taken up for disposal, among these 326 numbers of cases were disposed of and the total settlement Rs. 26,600 /- was realised as settlement amount.

- iv. On 07.07.2019, under SDLSC, Kailashahar, a Special Lok Adalat was conducted where, 840 numbers of cases under M.V Act & Tripura Police Act were taken up for disposal, among these 619 number of cases were disposed of and the total settlement amount was Rs. 1,23,750 /-.
- v. On 28.08.2019, under SDLSC, Bishalgarh, a Special Lok Adalat was conducted where, 200 number of cases under M.V Act & Tripura Police Act were taken up for disposal, among these 79 number of cases were disposed of and the total settlement amount was Rs. 6,490 /-.
- vi. On 10.09.2019, under SDLSC, Longorai velley, a Special Lok Adalat was conducted where, 865 number of cases under M.V Act & Tripura Police Act were taken up for disposal, among these 795 number of cases were disposed of and the total settlement amount was Rs. 44,250 /-.

National Lok Adalat :

- i. On 22.04.2018, National Lok Adalat was conducted as per guidelines of NALSA wherein 4130 numbers of cases were taken up for disposal in total 46 Nos. of Courts and out of those 701 nos. of cases were disposed of on settlement and a sum of Rs. 1,41,48,389.50/- was realized as settlement amount.
- ii. On 13.07.2019, National Lok Adalat was conducted as per guidelines of NALSA wherein 6018 number of cases were taken up for disposal in total 48 Nos. of Courts and out of these 795 nos. of cases were disposed of on settlement and a sum of Rs. 1,52,75,409/- was realized as settlement amount.
- iii. On 14.09.2019, National Lok Adalat was conducted as per guidelines of NALSA wherein 2324 number of cases were taken up for disposal in total 44 Nos. of Courts and out of these 378 nos. of cases were disposed of on settlement and a sum of Rs. 2,20,18,792/- was realized as settlement amount.



As a part of legal aid activities, PLVs always strive to perform assigned duties on different Lok Adalats which were organized by Tripura State Legal Services Authority. They also devoted their services in Lok Adalats, for preparation / dispatch of notices in time and in addition, assisted people who appeared in the Lok Adalats after receiving such notices to find out the proper court by providing court no., case no. etc. among other allied services/assistance.

SUCCESS STORIES

*S*uccess in Resolving Long Pending Marital Dispute

On 3rd April 2019, an application was made by Sri Madhu Sarkar in the East Mirza Village Legal Care and Support Centre under SDJSC, Udaipur in-connection with matrimonial dispute. They were unhappy and were not ready to lead conjugal life with each other between Sri Madhu Sarkar and his wife Smt. Beauty Pal (Sarkar). Their married life was unhappy and both of them were not ready to stay together.

After receiving the application, both the parties were called for and counselling was started with them. Initially, the parties were adamant and wanted to break their marital tie. But after continuous effort at counselling, the misunderstandings between the parties and away withered or disappeared both the parties agreed to live together peacefully. At present Sri Madhu Sarkar is living happily with his wife Smt. Beauty Pal (Sarkar). Thus the PLV, Shri Sushil Das of East Mirza, VLC&SC has done a commendable job and this matter may be treated as a success story of Legal aid Clinic.

*S*uccess in resolving long boundary dispute

On 2nd June, 2019 at East Harim G.P VLC&SC, one complain was received from Sri Nitai Debnath, S/O- Late Jadu Gopal Debnath of Paschim Harim, P.S- Sabroom, South Tripura regarding a land dispute between him and Runa Das regarding boundary of their land. Thereafter, notices were issued to both the parties to appear on 23rd June, 2019 for settlement of dispute through counselling.

On the said date both the parties were present and the Advocate in-charge, Sri Sudhan Chandra Majumder Counsellor both the parties effectively and lastly the dispute related with the land boundary was amicably settled between both the parties and the settlement to that effect was recorded with signatures and thus the disputes was settled at pre-litigation stage successfully and till now no further complain is received from their end.

*S*uccess in resquing and reestablishing a Mental Disabled Patient

On 26th May, 2019, one Smt Beauty Paul was found roaming on the street of Mirza and this came to the notice of the PLV namely Saheli Ali of Mirza Village legal care and support Centre. Immediately, he informed the D/C, Kakraban P.S for rescue of Smt. Beauty Paul. After resquing, it is found that Smt Paul was mentally disturbed and she didn't able to speak her name and address. She was taken for treatment at District Hospital, Gomati where from she was referred to the Modern psychiatric Hospital at Narasingarh, Agartala. There she undergone treatment and presently her mental condition has largely improved and Doctor told that she will be recovered soon.



Success story of one Retired School Teacher Prabir Kumar Bhowmik

One Prabir Kumar Bhowmik of Dhaleswar Road No-6, a Legal Aid Seeker, is a retired Teacher came to Legal Assistance Establishment on 31st May 2019. He gave a written application, praying for counselling in respect of a dispute regarding purchase of green marble. The Legal Aid seeker stated in his application that he bought green marble from one M/s Tirupati balaji Marble shop, situated at Chanpurmath under Bodhjungnagar Police station area for an amount of Rupees 1 lakh 67 thousand on 15th April, 2019. After purchase he paid Rs. 1,50,000/- by cheque and there was a condition that the balance amount of Rs. 17,000/- will be paid within 10 days after checking of the marbles in respect of their breakage etc. After checking it appear that some marbles are in broken condition and the colours of the green marble is not in good condition. In the mean time a representative of M/s Tirupati Balaji came to the house of Sri Prabir Kumar Bhowmik when he was not in his house and his wife and daughter showed the broken marble pieces and told the representative to take back the same. But the representative of the M/s Tirupati Balaji appealed before his wife that she can pay Rs. 5000/- only then their balance amount will be fully cleared. Accordingly his wife paid Rupees 5,000/- to the representative and he went away without taking the defective marble.

After some days, one night at 8 Pm when there was no power and it was raining, the Owner of Tirupati came to the house of Sri Bhowmik in his absence and insisted on opening of the door but his wife did not open the door.

Thereafter, the person from Tirupati Balaji frequently rang up and visit his home and harassed him. Sri Bhowmik being a Senior citizen and ailing person seeked for redress from the Legal Assistant Establishment. His complain was lodged accordingly and notice was served upon M/s Tirupati balaji Marble shop. Both the parties were present on 14th June, 2019 and the dispute between the parties resolved through counselling. Sri Bhowmik have no other complain against the opposite parties in this regard. Opposite party also paid the amount of Rs. 5000/- to him.

Success story of Jahanara Begam and Md. Anchar Ali

A person namely Md. Anchar Ali, S/O- Late Michir Ali resident of Pakirbadha, tortured his wife namely Jahanara Begam on demand of dowry. Jahanara often goes to local Police Station to lodge FIR against her husband. Md. Anchar Ali thereafter give 'Talak' to his wife. The matter became sensitive due to religious rules. On 9th June, 2019 Md. Anchar Ali came to Tilabazar village legal care and support centre and prayed for counselling between him and his wife. PLV of that clinic arranged counselling.



He arranged counselling on several occasion between the parties but all efforts went in vain. But due to persistent counselling both the party ready to live jointly again. Now they live together happily. Last counselling was made on 30th June 2019. PLV of the clinic often visit their home and found them living happily.

Success in Resolving Long Marital Dispute

On 11.08.2019, one Smt. Ruma Begam, W/o lamir Ali, Irani PS, Kailashahar, came to the Village Legal Care and Support Centre, Irani with an allegation against her husband regarding domestic violence. The PLV attached to the Clinic namely Dilwar Hussain Khan registered her case as PLD No. 28/19. She complained that she was beaten brutally by her husband almost every day at night in drunken condition. They have 3 children out of wedlock.

On 05.08.2019, due to non-fulfilment of required amount of dowry demanded by lamir Ali, he beaten up Smt. Ruma Begam to death alongwith the children till the local area police rescued her and take her to her own parent's house.

On hearing, PLV issued notice against her husband and when lamir Ali did not appear before the clinic, the PLV visit him personally in his house for counselling. Then, on 25.08.2019, both of them appear before the Clinic for counselling and after long discussion and repeated counselling both of them agreed to live together peacefully with their children. Till today no dispute has arise again and PLV personally visit their home every week and it seems to him that they were living in a happy conjugal life.
